RULES AND REGULATIONS

Dear Member,

The Palisades Swim Club provides an attractive, congenial, safe, and sanitary place for families to swim, play tennis, and have fun. It is every member's responsibility to help us maintain these standards by following the rules and regulations set down in this document. This will help ensure the greatest possible safety and enjoyment for all.

Members are required to become familiar with these rules, and to educate and inform their children and guests about them as well. Members are also required to obey the instructions of the Pool Manager and lifeguards while on the facility grounds. Failure to abide by the rules described in this document may result in suspension of privileges for the offending member. Repeated or willful disregard for Palisades Swim Club rules and regulations is considered sufficient cause for cancellation of membership and forfeiture of a member's bond.

It is the goal of the staff at the Palisades Swim Club to make your experience a positive one. Every member of the Board also stands ready to help you get the most out of your membership. I. 2017 POOL SEASON HOURS

The 2017 pool season shall begin on May 27, 2017 and, unless extended by the Board of Directors, shall close on Labor Day. Subject to the continuance of favorable weather conditions and the availability of lifeguards, the Board may extend the season beyond Labor Day, but in no case beyond September 17, 2017. In such case, the pool hours after Labor Day shall be posted on the pool bulletin board.

The 2017 pool hours shall be as follows (weather permitting):

Sunday, May 28	Noon to 7:00 P.M.
Monday, May 29	Noon to 7:00 P.M.
June 3–June 18	
Weekends	Noon to 7:00 P.M.
June 12–June 16	
Weekdays	3:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.
June 19–June 23	
Weekdays	Noon to 7:00 P.M.
June 24–July 31	
Daily (including weekends)	10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.
August 1–Labor Day	
Daily (including weekends)	10:00 A.M. to 7:45 P.M. or sunset, whichever comes earliest

II. GUEST PRIVILEGES

A. Regular Guest:

A guest privilege shall consist of admission to the Club area of one individual for the entire day schedule. No guest shall be admitted unless accompanied by his sponsoring member. Conduct of the guest shall be the responsibility of their supporting member.

B. Regular Guest Rates:

\$8.00 per person, payable upon entry

You may save on guest passes by purchasing packages of 10 online via the eSoft member system, or you may purchase passes at the front desk.

C. Special Member Guest Rates:

These special memberships may be purchased in advance for Nannies, Au Pairs, Babysitters, or Grandparents. Please be advised that Special Members may only come on to the property with

their charges. The rates are as follows: \$50.00 per month; \$100.00 per season. You may purchase special memberships in your eSoft account or contact us via email to assist you at palisadesswimclub@gmail.com.

D. No refunds shall be made.

III. CHILDREN

- A. All children under 9 years of age must be accompanied by an adult or a person 14 years of age or older.
- B. All non-swimming children are prohibited from entering the main pool if the water level is above their chin, unless a person 16 years or older who knows how to swim is in the pool with him/her and is providing direct, arms-length supervision.
- C. All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a person 16 years or older while on the club premises.
- D. Standards for determining swimming qualifications are the American Red Cross (A.R.C.) Water Safety Standards. "A qualified swimmer" is defined as one who has passed the "A.R.C. Intermediate Swimming Test," or is deemed to meet those qualifications as per the judgment and experience of the lifeguards or Pool Manager. Instruction courses will be given in swimming and water safety by a qualified A.R.C. Water Safety Instructor. Sections of the pool may be restricted during specific periods for swimming instruction. The Swimming Instruction Schedule will be posted.
- E. All persons using the deep water slide must be "qualified swimmers" as per American Red Cross (A.R.C.) Water Safety Standards.
- F. The main pool may be cleared at certain times of all children under 16 years of age, at the discretion of the Pool Manager, for the purpose of allowing others to use the pool exclusively.
- G. Use of the kiddie pool is limited to children under 7 years of age. No metal or rigid plastic toys are allowed in the kiddie pool. No child may be left unattended in the kiddie pool. Supervision is required by an adult or person 16 years of age or older.
- H. Any child using flotation devices must be within an arms length of a parent or other adult supervision directly responsible for the child.
- I. Use of the playground is limited to children under the age of 13. Bullying, pushing, shoving, and other objectionable behavior is strictly prohibited. Adults are responsible for the behavior of their children, and their guest's children, while on the playground.

IV. MEMBER OBLIGATIONS AND CONDUCT

- A. Members are responsible for ensuring that there are no outstanding/overdue guest fees, maintenance, or other monies due to the Club. Members are also responsible for ensuring that that Board has valid, verifiable proof-of-residency, address, phone number, and

email address information on file and in the Membership Management System. Examples of valid proof-of-residency include a tax bill and a utility bill (electricity, water) with the name(s) of the Primary and/or Associate Member on them. Driver's licenses are NO LONGER acceptable as valid proof-of-residency.

- B. Members are responsible for bringing their club-issued ID cards to the pool office to enable the recording of their visit to the pool. If the member's ID card is forgotten, the Primary or Associate member must show a picture ID for entrance to the pool. All members that have been issued Club ID cards are expected to bring them to the pool upon every visit.
- C. Members shall be responsible for any and all costs associated with damage to the Club resulting from one or more actions by that member. Members and their guest(s) shall be jointly and severably liable for any and all costs associated with damage to the club resulting from one or more actions by the guest(s).
- D. Members interested in holding an event at the pool that includes 20 or more invited guests must provide the details to the Board at least two weeks prior to the planned event date. Board approval is required for the event to be held at the pool. Additionally, the Board may require that the sponsoring member sign an Indemnification Agreement prior to the event.
- E. Abusive language, excessively loud music, or blatantly disrespectful or disorderly behavior by members or guests is prohibited, and is grounds for removal from the premises. Repeated offenses by a member may result in suspension of Club privileges for that member for up to one month. Repeated offenses by a guest may result in that guest being barred from the Club for the remainder of the season.
- F. The Pool Manager, at his/her discretion, may order members and guests off the Club premises for any violation or infraction of the By-Laws or these Rules of the Club. The Pool Manager shall report such incidences to the Board of Directors.
- G. Vehicles must be driven slowly and carefully on access roads and in the parking lot. Excessive speed is expressly prohibited. Also please note that Chipman Road is privately owned and must not be used to park member or guest vehicles.
- H. All bicycle riders shall ride carefully; they must keep off private property, and must respect the property of Club neighbors. Bicycles shall be parked in designated areas.

V. HEALTH AND SAFETY

- A. In accordance with the State Sanitary Code, no persons having skin lesions, sore or inflamed eyes, mouth, nose, or ear discharge will be admitted to the pool.

- B. In accordance with the State Sanitary Code, urinating, expectorating, or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
- C. Proper bathing attire will be required in the pool. No street clothing, or variations of the same, will be permitted. Street shoes are not allowed on the paved deck.
- D. No smoking is permitted on club property.
- E. No pets allowed on the club property.
- F. No glass containers of any kind allowed on club property.
- G. No running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area is allowed.
- H. Kapok or cord jackets or air-filled tubes shall not be permitted in the pool nor shall underwater masks, flippers, snorkels, “mermaid tails”, etc.
- I. No chewing gum is allowed on club property.
- J. All refuse must be deposited in proper receptacles.

VI. USE OF CLUB FACILITIES

- A. Bathhouse: All clothing must be placed in the bins provided. Personal belongings must be recovered from the bathhouse and grounds at the end of each day. The Club is not responsible for any items left in the bathhouse at any time.
- B. General area: Playpens, baby carriages, car beds, strollers, shall be permitted only in designated areas. All of these items must be removed from the Club property by the close of each day.

VII. GENERAL RULES

- A. All persons using any of the Club’s facilities do so at their own risk. The Club will not be responsible for any accidents or injury in connection with use of the Club’s facilities.
- B. The Club will not be responsible for loss of or damage to personal property. No personal property shall be accepted for safekeeping.

- D. Guest privileges may be restricted at any time in the best interest of the Club.
- E. The Board of Directors may revise these Rules and Regulations at any time. Notice of any changes or additions will be posted on the Club bulletin Board, and may be distributed to Club Membership via e-mail.
